Suggested Options:

Option 1: Calculation = \$106,500 (SSG 92.0%) + \$66,720 (Harvest Time 87.2%) + \$37,000 (Heathy House 76.9%) = \$210,220; then, divide \$210,220 by 3, and split difference evenly, with extra dollar going to SSG. Funds the "four walls" programs that prevent homelessness (housing, food, utilities, and transportation) at the percentages indicated in parentheses. No funds left to allocate to other projects.
