
# Old Dominion Annexation Pre-Application #24-03

## Pre-Application Process (Adopted July 2021)

- 1. Applicant submits an "Annexation Pre-application."
- 2. Meeting(s) with City staff.
- 3. Item is scheduled for City Council consideration.
- 4. Planning staff presents a report for City Council with analysis of "merit criteria" & the project's infrastructure needs.
- 5. The City Council will indicate general support or non-support for application moving forward.
- 6. Applicant Decides Whether or Not to Proceed.



Current Pre-Annexation and Annexation Projects: North Merced










Proposed Conceptual Land Use Map

#### **Utilities & Services**

#### At time of an annexation application:

- Will be evaluated through environmental review.
- Could be connected via Bellevue Road and G Street

#### **POLICE**

- Proximity to Police Station Approx 4.3 miles
- A satellite Police Station is planned with VST

#### FIRE

Proximity to Fire Station 55 – Approx. 2.5 miles

### Potential Issues

- Biological Resource Limitations: Environmental Review at the time of annexation will define issues and mitigations.
- MID canals crossing proposed development area
- Amount of usable open space provided within the proposed open Space reserves
- The need for new trunk lines to convey wastewater
- Dam breach analysis, as the project is downstream from Lake Yosemite
- Lack of Police radio communication in north Merced
