**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, CREATING AN
AD-HOC COMMITTEE FOR THE REVIEW,
SCORING AND RECOMMENDATION OF
PROPOSALS FOR THE FY 26/27 COMMUNITY
FUNDING**

WHEREAS, at the June 1, 2026 City Council Meeting for the City of Merced ("City"), the City designated \$30,000 for the FY 26/27 Community Funding; and

WHEREAS, the Community Funding Request for Proposals was advertised beginning June 18, 2026 and closed on July 9, 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Council Policy C-8, adopted on February 2, 2026 City Council Meeting, Staff is requesting an Ad-Hoc committee of three (3) city council members be established to review, score and recommend proposals to receive FY 26/27 Community Funding; and

WHEREAS, each committee representative will review and score the proposals individually; and

WHEREAS, after the Ad-Hoc committee representatives complete their individual review, a meeting will be scheduled for the Ad-Hoc committee representatives to discuss their reviews and scores, and select the proposals that will be recommended to receive FY 26/27 Community Funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, FIND, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the City creates an Ad-Hoc Committee, consisting of the following City Councilmembers: _____, _____ and _____ to review, score and recommend proposals to receive FY 2026-2027 Community Funding.

SECTION 2. That this Ad-Hoc Committee will begin July 21, 2026 and shall close on October 30, 2026.
