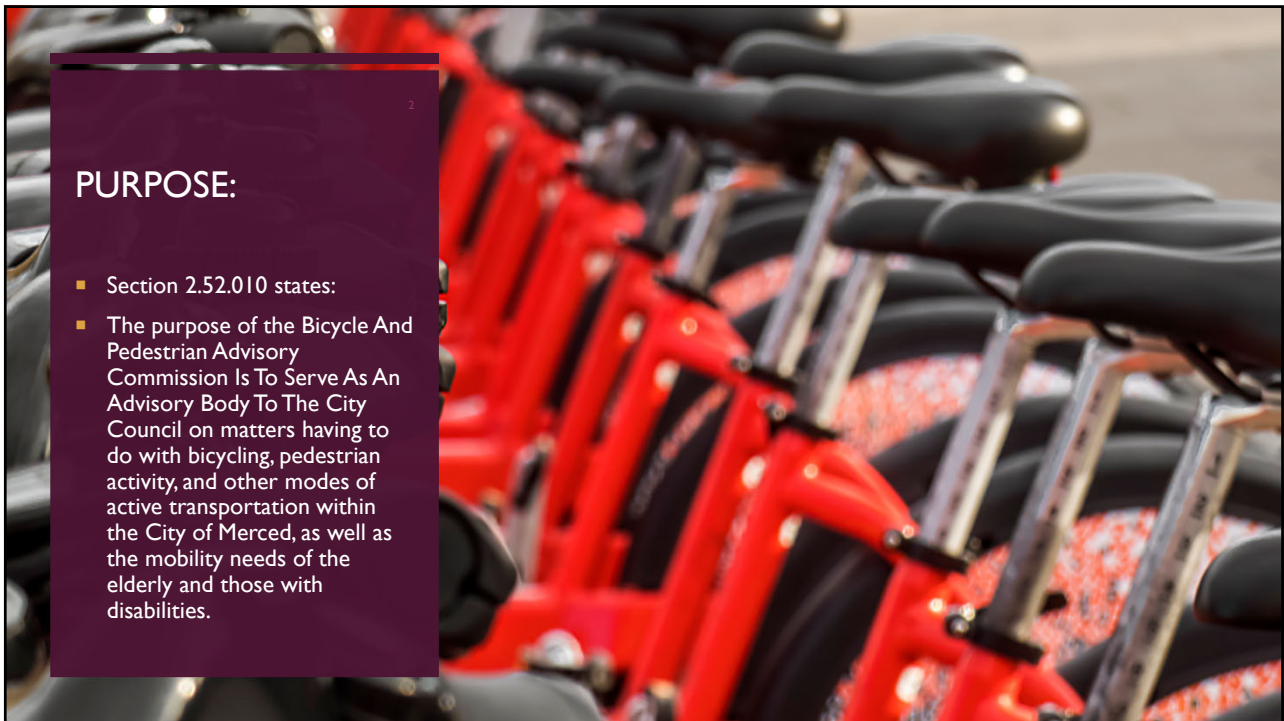

OPERATIONS:

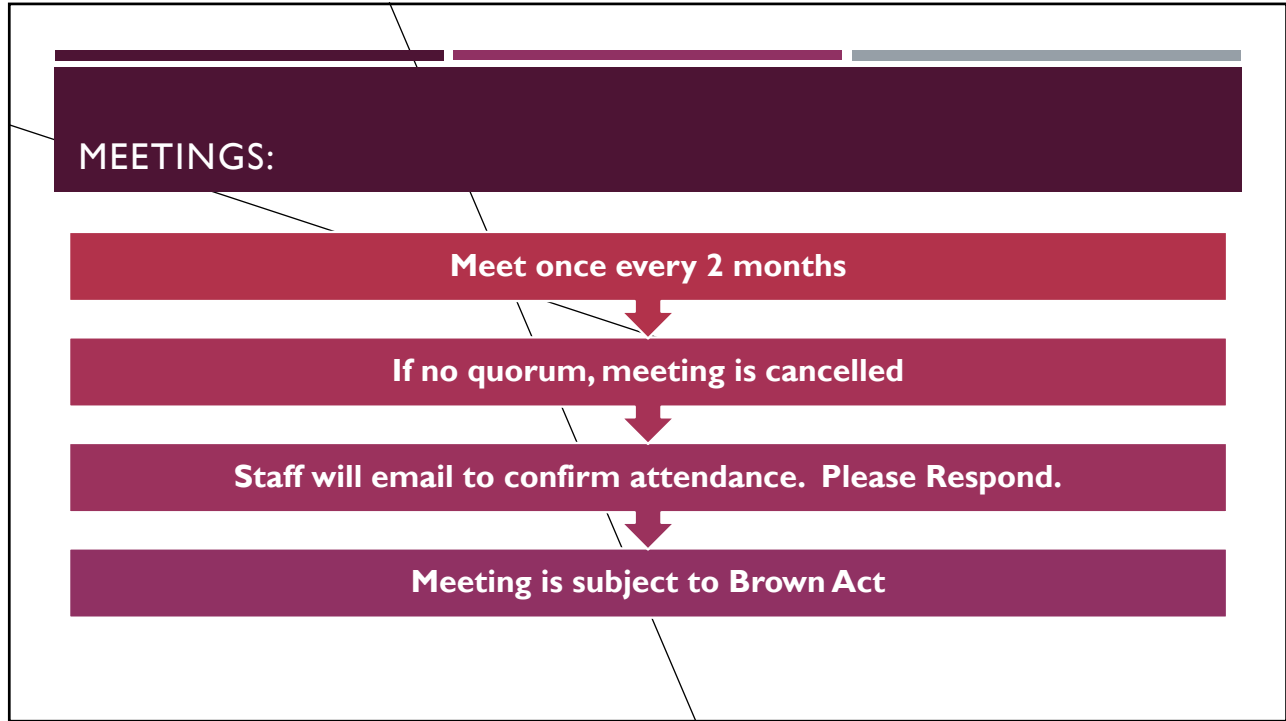
- **7 voting members – 6 representing each district and one at-large**
- **At least 2 shall be from a recognized bicycle organization**
- **The City Council may appoint an additional 4 members to sit as ex-officio or non-voting members**
- **Must Elect a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson**

RESPONSIBILITIES AS DIRECTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OR REQUESTED BY STAFF:

- Review and advise on the design of capital improvement projects, street improvements, and parking facility projects as they relate to bicycling, pedestrian activity, or other active transportation issues.
- Review and advise on changes and updates to the active transportation, safe-routes-to-school plan, and General Plan, Municipal Code and other policy documents which relate to active transportation.
- Promote any and all forms of active transportation as a viable form of transportation.
- Assist in the development and dissemination of awareness and education materials for all forms of active transportation to the community.
- Initiate requests to city staff from the community on issues of concern related to bicycling, pedestrian issues, and issues that relate to other forms of active transportation or the transportation needs of elderly individuals or those with disabilities.
