## PROCLAMATION OF THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 8.20.070, subdivision A. of the Merced Municipal Code empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. the City Manager, as Director of Emergency Services of the City, issued a issued a proclamation of the existence of a local emergency ("Proclamation") due to flood and storm pursuant to section 8.20.070, subdivision A. of the Merced Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Merced has not been called into session since the Proclamation because of the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, as Director of Emergency Services of the City does hereby find that:

- 1. Conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property continue to exist within the City of Merced caused by flood and storm commencing on or about [:0] p.m. on the 14th of January, 2023.
- 2. That the City Council of the City of Merced is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED, that a local emergency now exists throughout the City.

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those prescribed by state law, Ordinances, and Resolutions of this City and by the City of Merced Emergency Plan.
