## Proposed Legislation

**AB 2797 (June 10<sup>th</sup>) : Redefines COLR**

*This bill would no longer require a telephone corporation seeking relief from carrier of last resort obligations to be a carrier of last resort or to have any carrier of last resort obligations if the telephone corporation submits a notice containing certain information to the commission and modifies and removes its commission tariffs.*

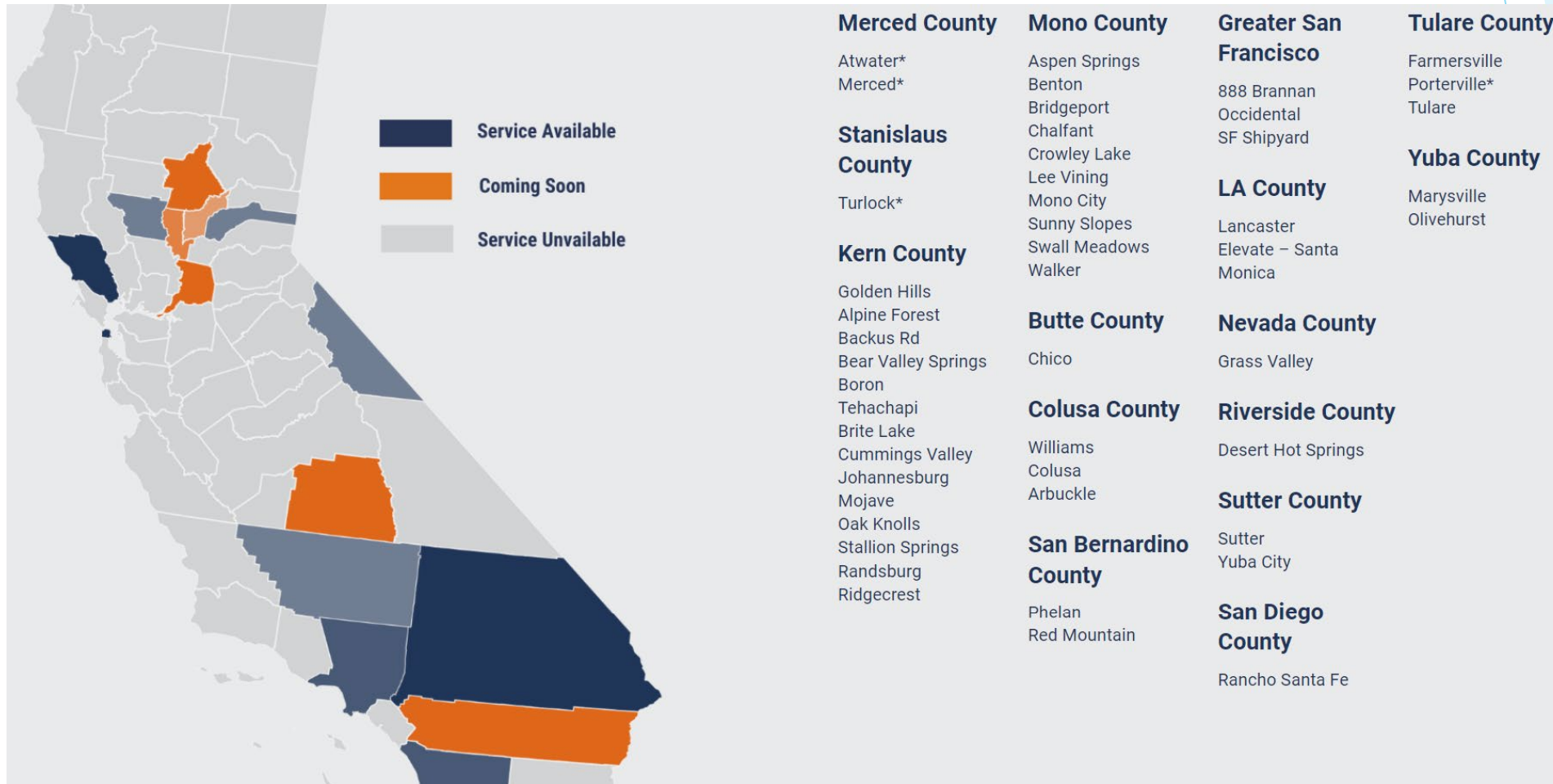
Redefined Broadband speeds : March 2024
