

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-_____**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A
LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025
FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND
ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide;

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Merced are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the City of Merced must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement;

WHEREAS, the City of Merced, will receive an estimated \$2,306,281 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2024-25 from SB 1;

WHEREAS, this is the eighth year in which the City of Merced is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of Merced to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1;

WHEREAS, the City of Merced has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list;

WHEREAS, the City of Merced used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment;

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Merced maintain and rehabilitate streets, sidewalk infill projects, a Pedestrian Bridge repair project, and pedestrian and bicycle safety improvement projects throughout the City of Merced this year and many similar projects into the future;

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City of Merced's streets and roads are in an at-risk or poor condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into an "excellent/good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive benefits in the City of Merced.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, FIND, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2024 - 25 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

SECTION 3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2024-25 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of Merced is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
