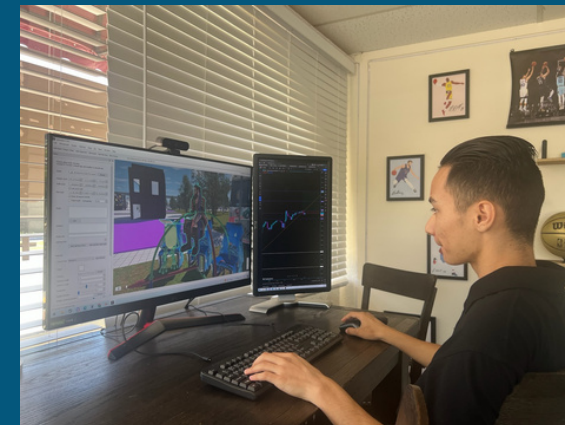

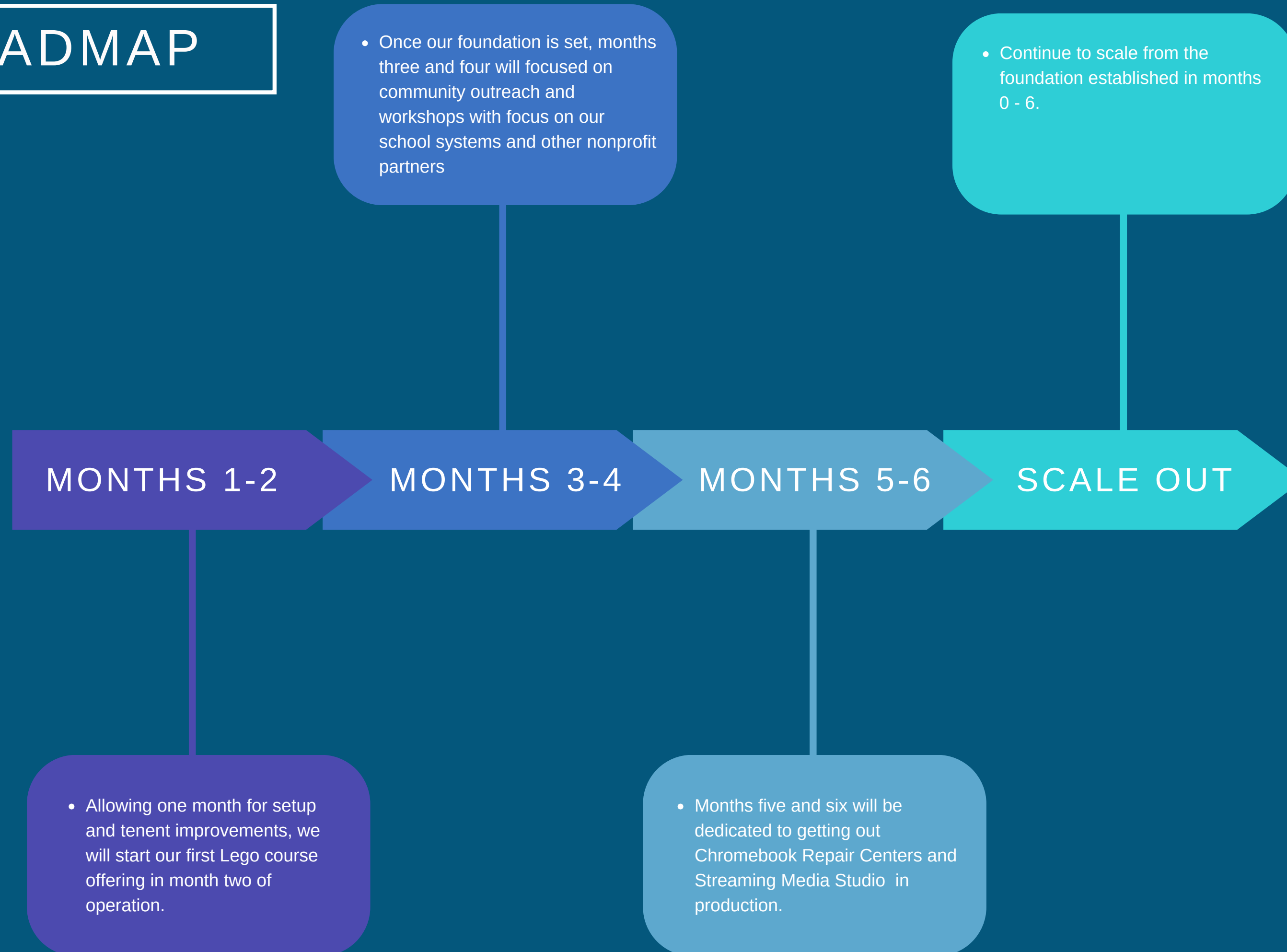

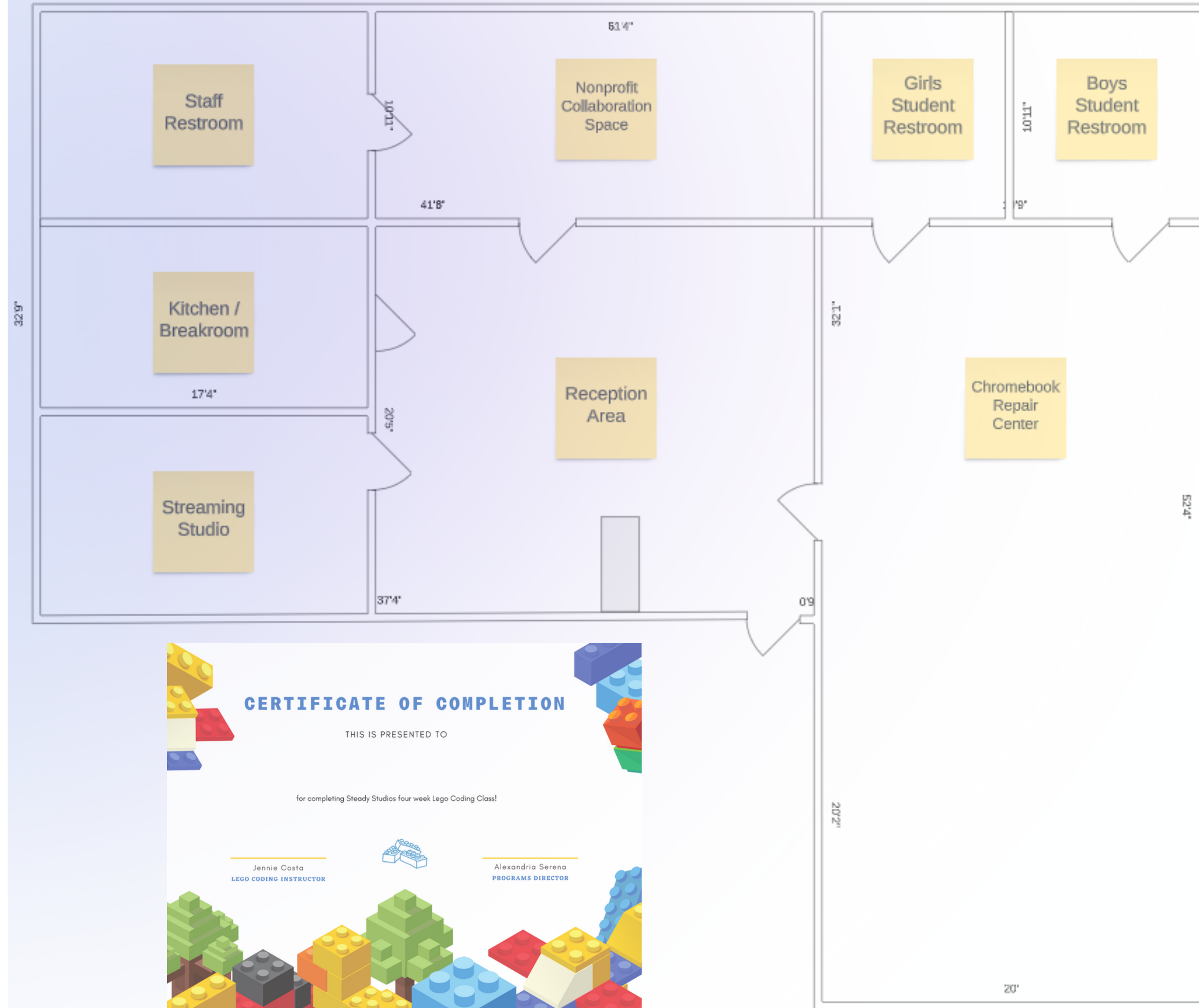


LEGO CLASS IMPACT

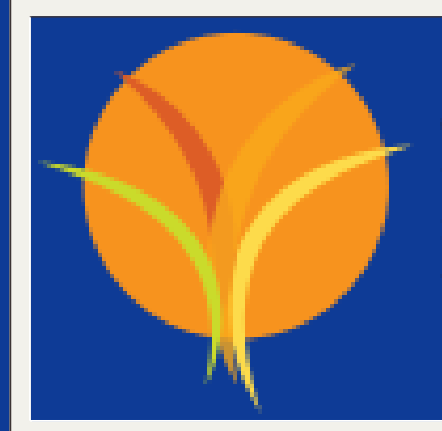

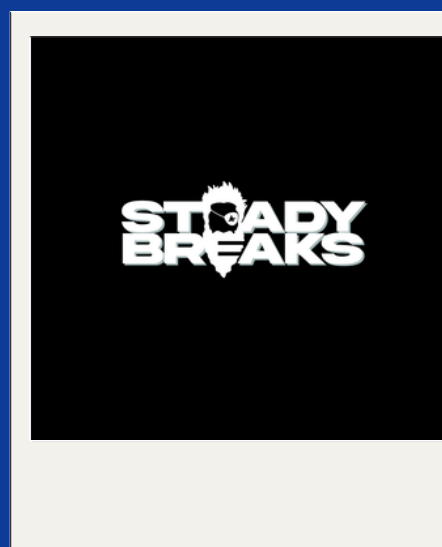
