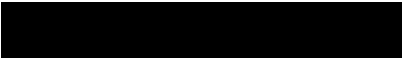

I've been an active cyclist since age 5, averaging 4-6 thousand miles/year on bicycles for the last 35 years. Merced has a good head start in providing safe and enjoyable bike paths and routes, but more than a few of the local bike paths need both regular maintenance and significant repairs. The health and environmental benefits of getting people out on bikes are clear, making it as easy and desirable for them to do is my goal.

I'm a retired family physician that commuted to work by bicycle (18 miles roundtrip) for 25 years in Central Oregon, regardless of the weather. When I retired, I became active in the U.S. Forestry volunteer corps, working for three years with groups of men and women to clear trails of fallen trees in wilderness areas. Chainsaws are not allowed in wilderness areas, so we worked with cross-cut saws. I've also volunteered in a prison library (Deer Ridge Correctional Facility, Madras, Oregon), developing a prisoner's book club that met every two weeks for three years, stopping when COVID prevented volunteers from working in prisons. I also served as a volunteer physician for eight years working with End of Life Choices, Oregon. Lastly I volunteered with Central Oregon Trail Association, a group dedicated to developing and maintaining mountain bike trails in Central Oregon.

I am assuming that the board has an advisory role regarding bicycle routes and paths in Merced County. I'm hoping that the role is not a "window-dressing" role demanded by grants. 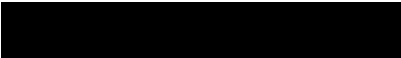
