Resolution #4185

WHEREAS, the Merced City Planning Commission at its regular meeting of June 3, 2026, held a public hearing and considered a Staff Report prepared by the Engineering Division regarding the Draft Project List for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 and the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for Fiscal Years 2026-2031 (CIP Staff Report); and

WHEREAS, the CIP is a planning and budgeting document identifying physical improvements and infrastructure projects proposed for funding and construction during the next five years, including transportation, utilities, public safety, parks, drainage, and other municipal facilities; and

WHEREAS, CIP serves as an important implantation tool for the Merced Vision 2030 General Plan by supporting infrastructure planning, public facility improvements, transportation enhancements, public safety services, utility infrastructure, and recreation amenities; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the proposed CIP projects and determined that the projects are consistent with and do not conflict with any adopted policies, text, or maps contained within the Merced Vision 2030 General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered all written and oral testimony presented regarding the proposed CIP and General Plan consistency determination.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, FIND AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Planning Commission concurs with and adopts the CIP Staff Report.

SECTION 2. That the Planning Commission finds the projects identified in the CIP are consistent with the text, goals, policies, maps, and implementation measures of the Merced Vision 2030 General Plan, including but not limited to policies related to circulation, transportation, public facilities, water, wastewater, storm drainage, parks, open space, and public safety.

SECTION 3. That the Planning Commission recommends that the City Council of the City of Merced adopt a finding that the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (2026–2031) is consistent with the Merced Vision 2030 General Plan.
