History

 2021 and 2022-Nationwide Settlements to resolve all opioids litigation by states and local political subdivisions against largest pharmaceutical distributors.



- \$26 billion over 18 years
- 85% goes directly to participating states and subdivisions for abatement of opioid epidemic and future abatement efforts
- 2022-City Council elected to receive direct allocations of the distributions
 - City anticipates to receive \$1.1 million over 15 years
 - Ranges from \$39,000 to \$135,000 per fiscal year.

Reporting

- ► Annual Reports due September 30th to California Department of Health Care Services
 - ▶ Distributions Received
 - ► Settlements and Bankruptcy
 - ► Interest Allocations
 - ► Expenditures by Approved Activity
 - Must be expended or encumbered 5 years from receipt or 7 years for capital outlay
- ▶ Reports submitted and approved by the State
 - ► FY 22-23
 - ► FY 23-24


