**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA,
REQUESTING APPROVAL TO APPLY FOR THE
CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY'S
TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Merced Police Department is requesting approval to apply for the FY 26/27 California Office of Traffic Safety's Traffic Enforcement Program Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the Merced Police Department has been applying for grant funding from the California Office of Traffic Safety dating back to at least October 2007; and,

WHEREAS, the Merced Police Department must submit the application by January 31, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, the grant's mission is to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in alcohol involved crashes and other primary collision factors; and,

WHEREAS, the grant provides funding on overtime status to conduct operations such as DUI checkpoints, DUI patrols, traffic safety, motorcycle safety, pedestrian/bicycle safety, distracted driving, street racing and sideshow enforcement, and educational presentations; and,

WHEREAS, the grant provides funding for equipment and supplies to conduct operations that support the grant's mission; and,

WHEREAS, the grant will run from October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027; and,

WHEREAS, the grant does not require a match of any type (in-kind or cash); and, is a 100% reimbursement grant; and, funds are first expended by the MPD and then requests for reimbursement are submitted on a quarterly basis; and,

WHEREAS, this year's grant application will be similar to last year's application including a request for funding for: personnel and benefits \$125,000, travel \$2,500, and equipment and supplies \$300,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCEDES
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, FIND, AND ORDER AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager or designee of the City of Merced is authorized to submit an application to the California Office of Traffic Safety's Traffic Safety Program Grant.
