RESOLUTION NO. 2023-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, ELECTING TO SERVE AS THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF MERCED, PURSUANT TO HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 34171(j) AND SECTION 34173

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1X 26 (the "Dissolution Act") and Assembly Bill 1X 27 (the "Alternative Redevelopment Program Act") were enacted on June 28, 2011, to significantly modify the Community Redevelopment Law (Health & Safety Code §33000, et seq.; the "Redevelopment Law");

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2011, the California Supreme Court agreed to review the California Redevelopment Association and League of California Cities' petition challenging the constitutionality of the Redevelopment Restructuring Acts;

WHEREAS, on December 29, 2011, the California Supreme Court ruled that the Dissolution Act is largely constitutional and the Alternative Redevelopment Program Act is unconstitutional;

WHEREAS, the Court's decision dissolved all California redevelopment agencies on February 1, 2012 pursuant to the Dissolution Act;

WHEREAS, the Dissolution Act provides that the city that authorized the creation of the redevelopment agency shall be the "successor agency" to the dissolved redevelopment agency unless the city elects not to serve as the successor agency under Section 34173(d)(1) of the Redevelopment Law; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Merced (the "City") intends to, and shall serve as, the successor agency for the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Merced (the "Agency") in accordance with Section 34171(j) and Section 34173 of the Redevelopment Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, FIND, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City hereby accepts the designation, and hereby elects, to serve as the successor agency for the Agency in accordance with Section 34171(j) and Section 34173 of the Redevelopment Law, beginning on July 1, 2023.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby directed to file a copy of this Resolution with the County Auditor-Controller.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption.
