## **RV/Trailer Parking Ordinances**

<u>City of Bellflower:</u> not allowed to be parked on street unless attached to a vehicle; not allowed to park on any street between the hours of midnight and 6:00am unless it is a moving trailer; permit allowed for overnight on-street parking (no more than 4 times in a 2-year period)

<u>City of Gardena:</u> no parking between 10:00pm and 6:00am; chief of police issues RV permits (valid for two years) to be displayed in the lower driver's side windshield; no extension cords or cables, no sewer connections or dumping

<u>City of Rancho Palos Verdes:</u> may be parked and stored on private property if they do not interfere with the sidewalk or landscaping; must be maintained and covered if parked in an area visible from the street (front yard, side yard, etc.); permit needed to park on the street

<u>City of San Luis Obispo</u>: overnight camping prohibited; may be parked in driveways with proper permitting; lots of info on tiny houses but not on trailers and RVs

<u>City of Woodland:</u> may be stored off the street if it is on an impervious surface and not used as living quarters; parking shall be prohibited in lawn or landscape areas; impervious surfaces should not exceed 40% of the front/side yard areas
