RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DESIGNATING THE BUILDINGS AND SITE LOCATED AT 575 WEST NORTH BEAR CREEK DRIVE AS A HISTORIC RESOURCE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES HEREBY RESOLVE
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council designates the buildings and site at 575 West North Bear Creek Drive (APN 07-310-02) as a historic resource.

SECTION 2. The City Council makes the following findings:

- The buildings and site have significance as a historic resource;
- 2. The buildings and site may be designated as a historic resource without imposing an undue hardship upon the owner of the property; and
- 3. The approval of the application for historic designation is consistent with the purpose and criteria of Chapter 17.54 of the Merced Municipal Code.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is directed to cause notice of adoption of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder against the parcel on which the historic resource is located and is further directed to send the owner(s) of the property a letter outlining the basis for the designation and the regulations resulting from the designation.
