Describe Concerns At This Location: I would like to request that an Advance STOP (W3-1) sign be installed on the approach to the intersection of Wardrobe Avenue and West Avenue. According to collision data obtained from the Traffic Injury Mapping System (TIMS), there have been four reported broadside collisions at this intersection between 2020 and 2022. It is likely that additional, unreported collisions have also occurred. All reported incidents involved broadside impacts, suggesting that some drivers may not be noticing or anticipating the existing STOP control. Installing an Advance STOP sign could help improve driver awareness and reduce the likelihood of further collisions.	
In addition, I would appreciate if staff could provide any previous traffic studies or evaluations that have been conducted at this location.
