Today, it operates 62 clinics across Merced, San Joaquin, and Stanislaus Counties, delivering more than 712,000 visits to over 162,000 patients annually; and
- **WHEREAS**, Golden Valley Health Centers employs 1,403 professionals dedicated to delivering compassionate, patient-centered services, including primary care, dental, behavioral health, optometry, and pharmacy, while addressing the social and economic factors that impact health; and
- **WHEREAS**, Golden Valley Health Centers plays a vital role in promoting community health, advancing equity, and reaching underserved populations such as agricultural workers, low-income families, seniors, and the unhoused; and
- **WHEREAS**, National Health Center Week (August 3–9, 2025) offers a time to recognize the longstanding, nonpartisan mission of Community Health Centers to provide accessible care and to honor the patients, staff, volunteers, and board members who make this work possible; and
- **WHEREAS**, During National Health Center Week, we celebrate the legacy of America's Community Health Centers and their vital role in shaping the past, present, and future of America's health care system; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Merced commends Golden Valley Health Centers for its continued service and commitment to the health and well-being of our resident;
