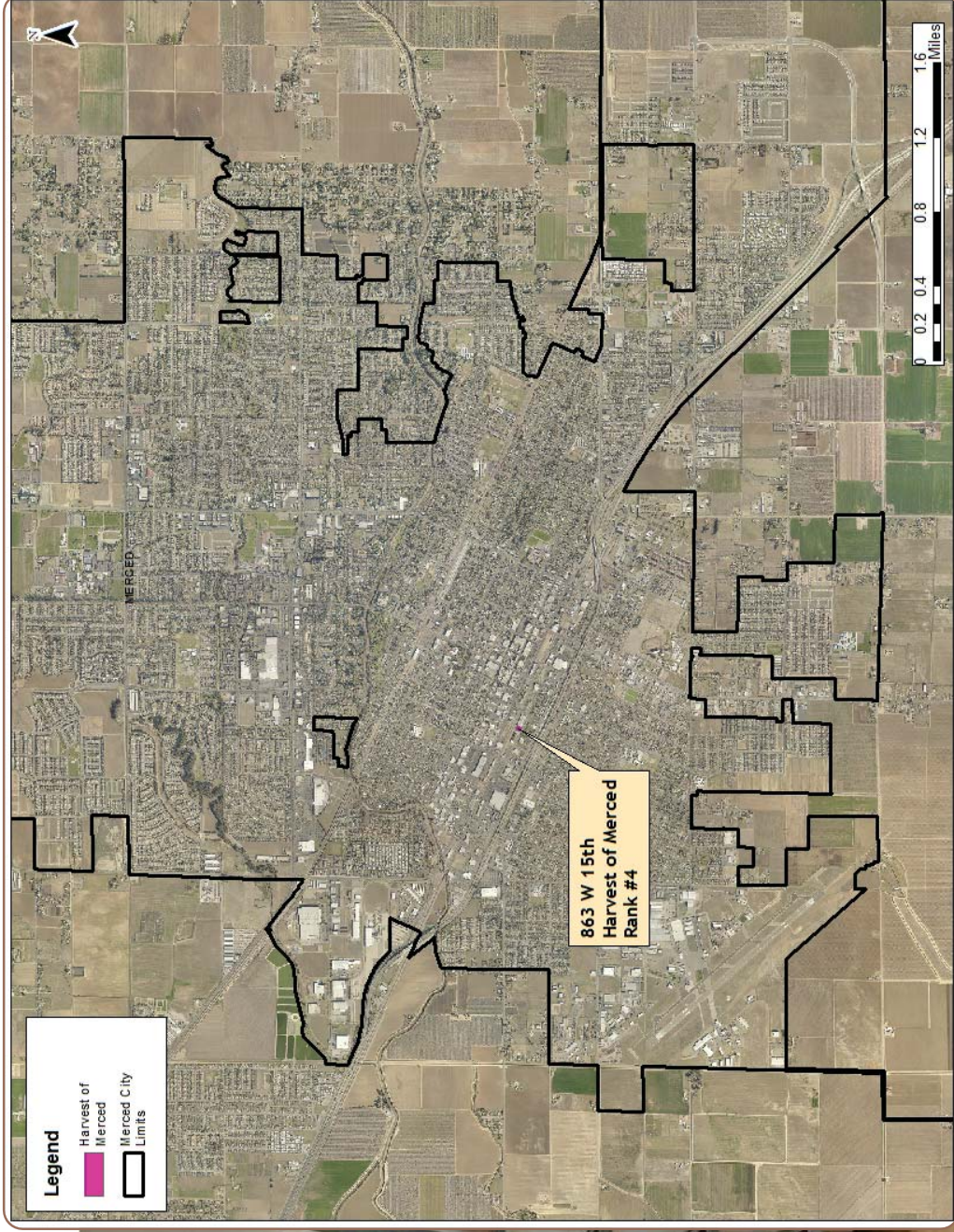

Planning Commission Hearing results in approval of CCBP #18-14R.

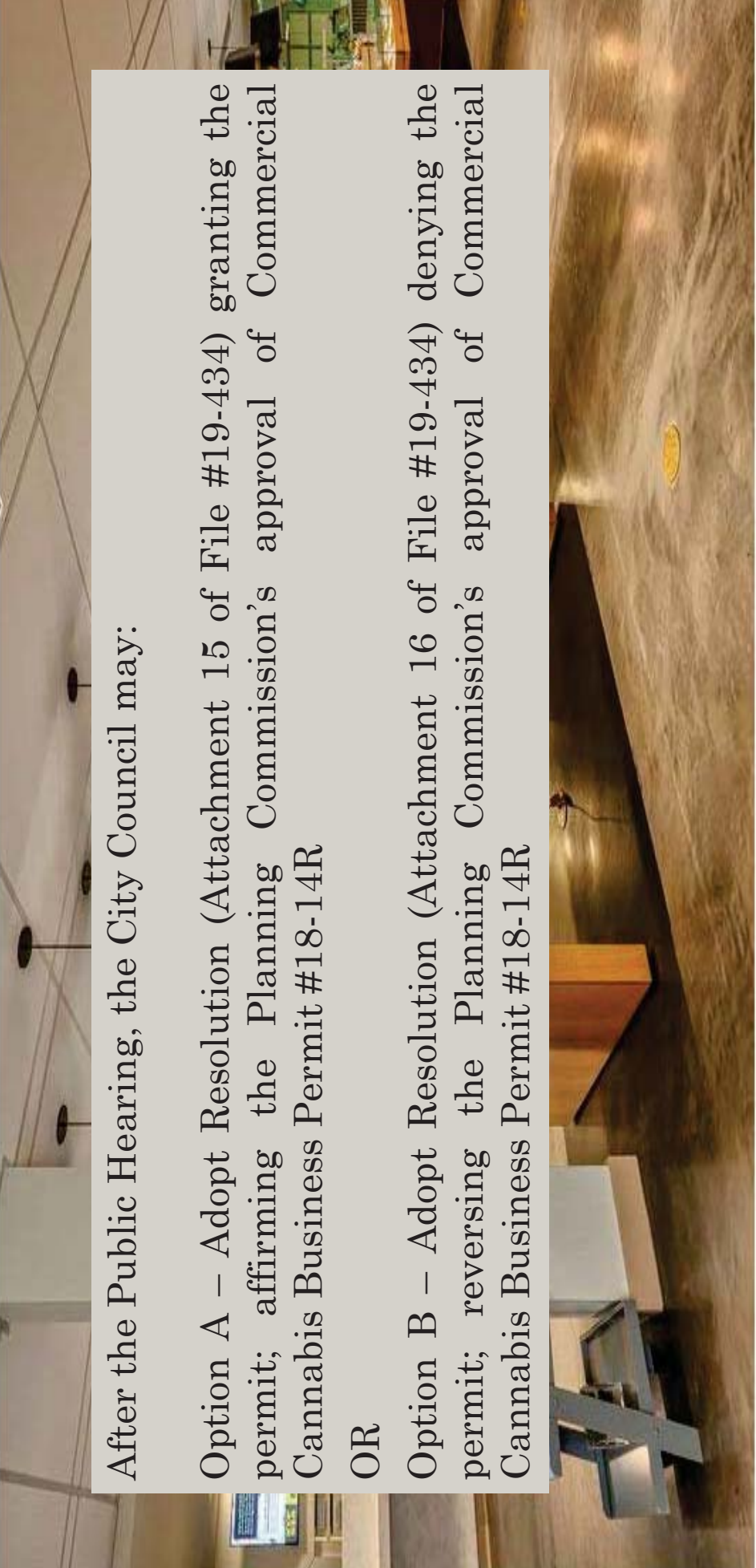

After the Public Hearing, the City Council may:

Option A – Adopt Resolution (Attachment 15 of File #19-434) granting the permit; affirming the Planning Commission’s approval of Commercial Cannabis Business Permit #18-14R

OR

Option B – Adopt Resolution (Attachment 16 of File #19-434) denying the permit; reversing the Planning Commission’s approval of Commercial Cannabis Business Permit #18-14R
