**Subject: E-76 AMODs for three City of Merced projects; Post Programming Adjustments for CML-5085(051), CML-5085(055), and CML-5085(061)**

The Merced County Association of Governments authorizes modifications for the following projects:

CML-5085(051): Construct Sidewalks Along Olive Avenue, Parsons Avenue, and Alexander Avenue. The City of Merced may increase federal construction funding for this project in the amount of \$80,600. These post-programming funds come from de-obligated and closed out CMAQ projects.

CML-5085(055): Pedestrian Improvements on Nottingham, Tamworth, Buckingham, and Alexander Avenue. The City of Merced may increase federal construction funding for this project in the amount of \$94,200. These post-programming funds come from de-obligated and closed out CMAQ projects.

CML-5085(061): Construct Childs Avenue Multiuse Path. The City of Merced may increase federal construction funding for this project in the amount of \$201,000. These post-programming funds come from de-obligated and closed out CMAQ projects.
