Do you have experience or special knowledge pertaining to the areas of interest?

I've served on an ad-hoc committee created by District 3 Board Supervisor Daron McDaniel concerning the economic development of Castle Commerce Center. Additionally, my participation within the MCAG "One Voice" committee has allowed me the opportunity to work collaboratively with other committee members/community leaders in advocating for Merced County needs of which have included planning. The committee meets to determine the county's needs ranging from social needs to economic, transportation, and natural resource advocacy. For instance, while serving on the committee in 2015, I advocated for the redistricting of HUB Zone (Highly Underutilized Business Zones) boundaries in Atwater (industrial park and Castle Commerce region) and Merced city. The committee supported the efforts and advocated at the federal level for redistricting which resulted in the SBA and RDA federal agencies interest in exploring more appropriate ways to capture HUB Zone's more accurately.

I have enhanced the reputation and progress of the organizations I've represented and have worked across industrial and social sectors allowing me to obtain a well-rounded understanding of community needs and their relation to local government inclusive of economic development and regional planning.
