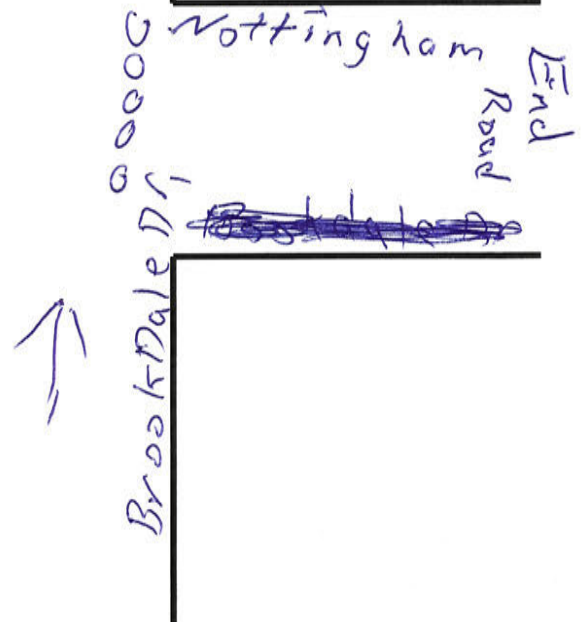

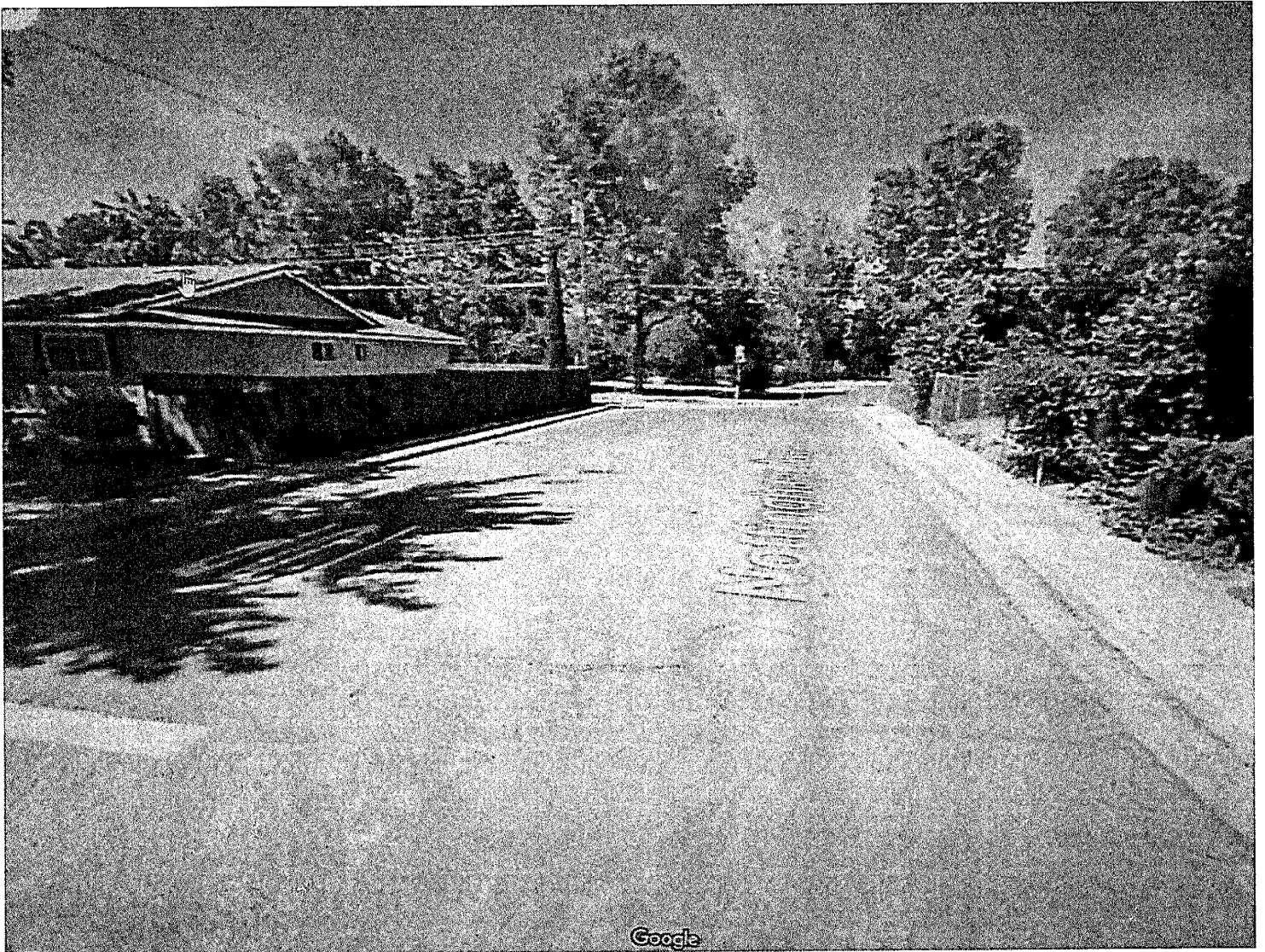

Thank you for considering this request. We look forward to your prompt action on this matter.

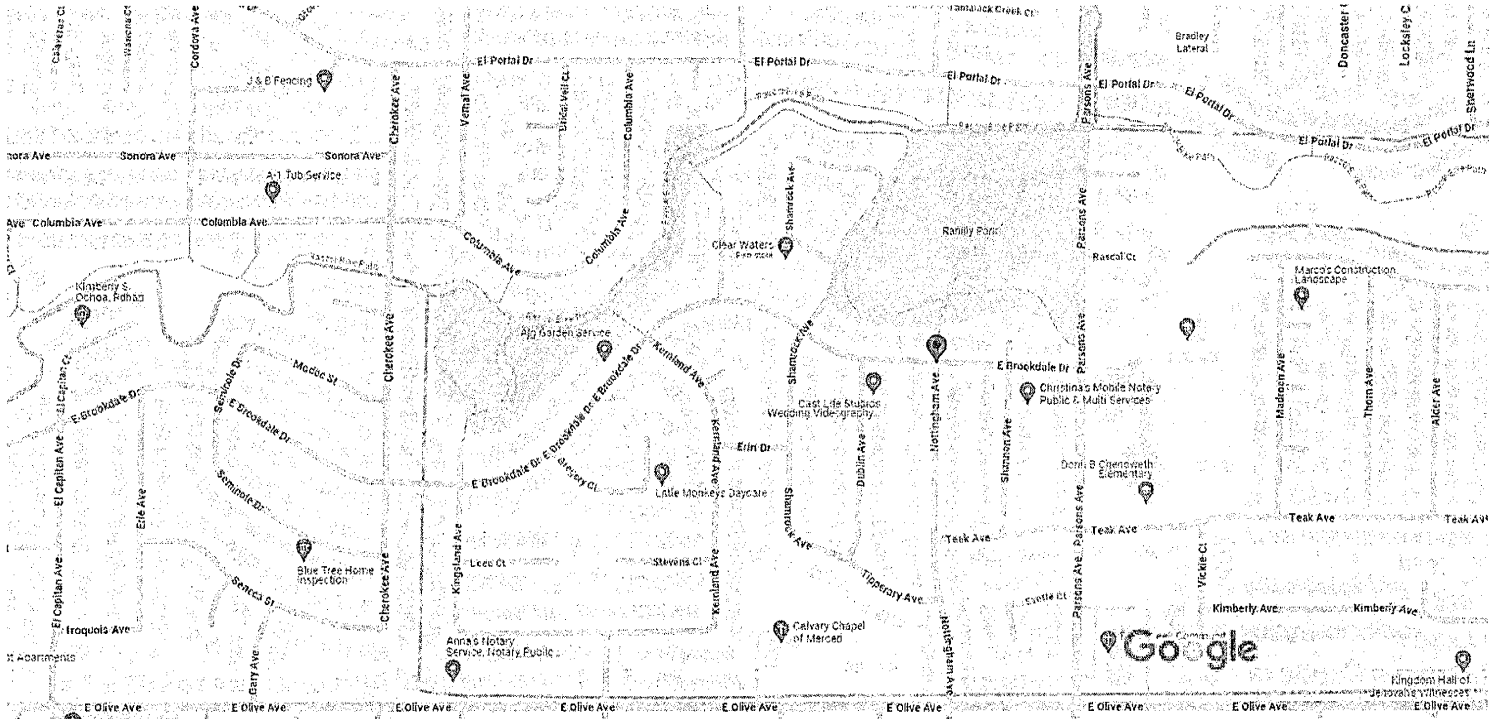

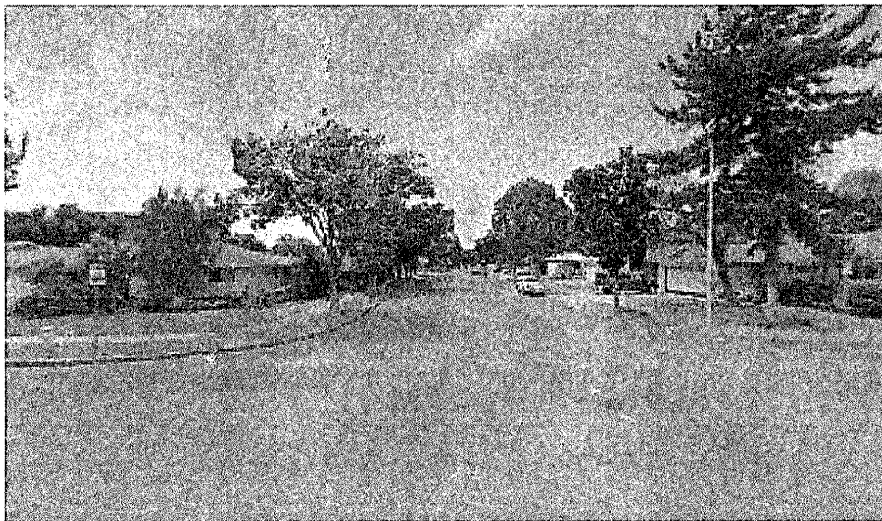
