
SB 1185 (enacted 7/15/2008)

Grants an automatic 12-month extension subject to the following:

- a) Map was approved prior to July 15, 2008
- b) Map had not expired as of July 15, 2008; and,
- c) Map would otherwise expire prior to January 1, 2011

AB 333 (enacted 7/15/2009)

Grants an automatic 24-month extension subject to the following:

- a) Map was approved prior to July 15, 2009
- b) Map had not expired on July 15, 2009; and,
- c) Map would otherwise expire prior to January 1, 2012

AB 208 (enacted 7/13/2011)

Grants an automatic 24-month extension subject to the following:

- a) Map was approved prior to July 15, 2011
- b) Map had not expired on July 15, 2011; and,
- c) Map would otherwise expire prior to January 1, 2014

AB 116 (enacted 7/11/2013)

Grants an automatic 24-month extension subject to the following:

- a) Map was approved on or after January 1, 2000; and,
- b) Map had not expired on July 11, 2013

AB 1303 (enacted 10/10/2015)

Grants an automatic 24-month extension subject to the following:

- a) Map was approved on or after January 1, 2002, and not later than July 11, 2013
- b) County meets criteria for Counties in Gov't Code Section 66452.2 (c)*; and,
- c) Map had not expired prior to October 10, 2015

*Merced County met the criteria

STATE GRANTED AUTOMATIC EXTENSIONS
FOR TENTATIVE SUBDIVISION MAPS

AB 2973 (enacted 9/27/2018)

Gov't Code Section 66452.26 – Requires action by the Legislative Body (City Council)

Grants 24-month extension if approved by the Legislative Body, subject to the following:

- a) Map approved on or after 1/1/2006 and not later than 7/11/2013; AND,
- b) Map was extended pursuant to Gov't Code Section 66452.25 (AB 1301); and
- c) Map had not expired by 9/27/18

AB 1561 (enacted 9/28/2020)

Gov't Code Section 65914.5

Grants automatic 18-month extension subject to the following:

- a) Map was approved prior to and was in effect on March 4, 2020
- b) Map would otherwise have expired prior to December 31, 2021
