Location of Concern (map attachments and photographs are encouraged):

Near the intersection of East Santa Fe Avenue and East Santa Fe Terrace, while headed in the direction of G Street, NW bound drivers are failing to veer left so as to remain on the road. They're jumping the curve directly in front of 155 E Santa Fe Avenue (where the bend is).

Describe Concerns At This Location:

All too often, northwest-bound drivers are failing to negotiate the left bend at the intersection of East Santa Fe Avenue and East Santa Fe Terrace. Such drivers (whether it be fatigue, DUI, or texting) are failing to steer left so as to stay on the road (E Santa Fe Avenue) - they're continuing straight ahead, thus jumping the curb and destroying city and personal property. Cases in point:

2021: J. Wheldon's PT Cruiser, PARKED in front of 155 E Santa Fe Ave was TOTALED.

Early 2024: A car went straight, jumped the curb, slammed into a city box, then overturned.

STOP sign was downed. City had to reinstall the downed STOP sign. City box remains TILTED.

This accident was caught on RING video, and was sent to Merced Police.
