MMC 3.38.010 Amendment

Requires the level of spending made by the City of Merced could not fall below the levels in Fiscal Year 2021-22, as a percentage of the total City budget, in the areas funded by the tax.

City Attorney has provided a determination of the how the baseline level of spending is calculated to ensure we are meeting the intent of the language for the levels of spending annually.

Finance will review that we are meeting the levels of spending during the budget process.
