**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, TO
APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING AND ACCEPT
GRANT FUNDING, IF AWARDED, IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$99,410.00 FROM THE SAN
JOAQUIN VALLEY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
DISTRICT'S PUBLIC BENEFITS GRANTS
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District's (SJVAPCD) Public Benefits Grants Program is seeking public agency applicants for the Emergency Vehicle Replacement Program and has set up necessary procedures governing the application;

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the SJVAPCD require the Applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application before submission of said application to the SJVAPCD; and,

WHEREAS, successful Applicants will enter into a contract with the SJVAPCD.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, FIND, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The submittal of an application to the SJVAPCD to participate in the Emergency Vehicle Replacement Program is authorized and approved.

SECTION 2. If the Grant funds are awarded, the City Manager or designee of the City of Merced is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Merced the Contract, including any extension or amendments thereof and any subsequent agreement with the SJVAPCD in relation thereto.

SECTION 3. The City Council agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.


