- ► HUD Notification Emailed to City Staff March 31st
- Allocations expected "on or around May 13, 2022"
- Extends submittal deadline to 60 days from announcement
- Requirements for Publicly Posted Draft:
  - Requires all amounts clearly stated as ESTIMATES while actual amounts are unknown
  - Requires Contingency Plan for how increases/ decreases will be handled
- Necessitates tonight's Second Public Hearing to be Continued to June 21st
