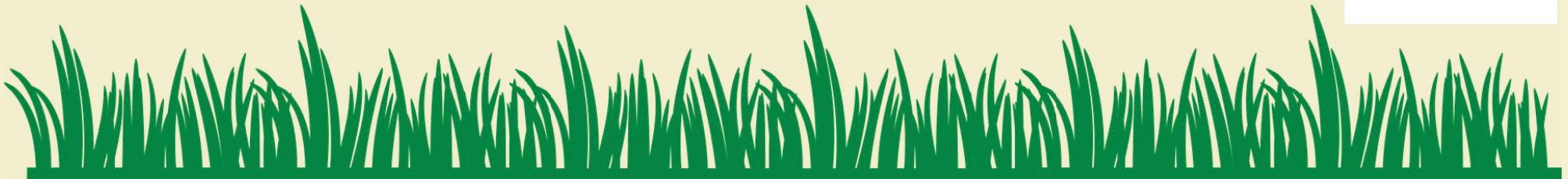
# What is SB 1383?

## Organic Waste

- Food waste
- Green Waste
- Landscape and pruning
- Nonhazardous wood waste
- Food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste



- This is another step to California's goals for reduction of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions through recycling/waste diversion efforts.
- Organic waste reduction mandate that requires the state to reduce organic waste disposal by 75% and to increase the edible food recovery by 20%.
- State-wide goals & Mandates



- Organic waste recycling program that includes residential and commercial customers.
  - Food Waste Diversion
  - Edible Food Recovery
- Education/Outreach
  - In the form of print and electronic/digital.
- Annual monitoring/reporting
  - Inspections
  - Tracking
