Retail Cannabis Business Permits

- Commercial Cannabis Business Permits are part of Zoning Ordinance
- Currently provides for Five retail permits
- Permit process for fifth permit started in January 2022
- Applications have been reviewed, ranked, and notice provided
- Currently there are two appeals – to be heard in April 2023

- Council expressed interest in potential modifications – proposed two-step process

Step 1

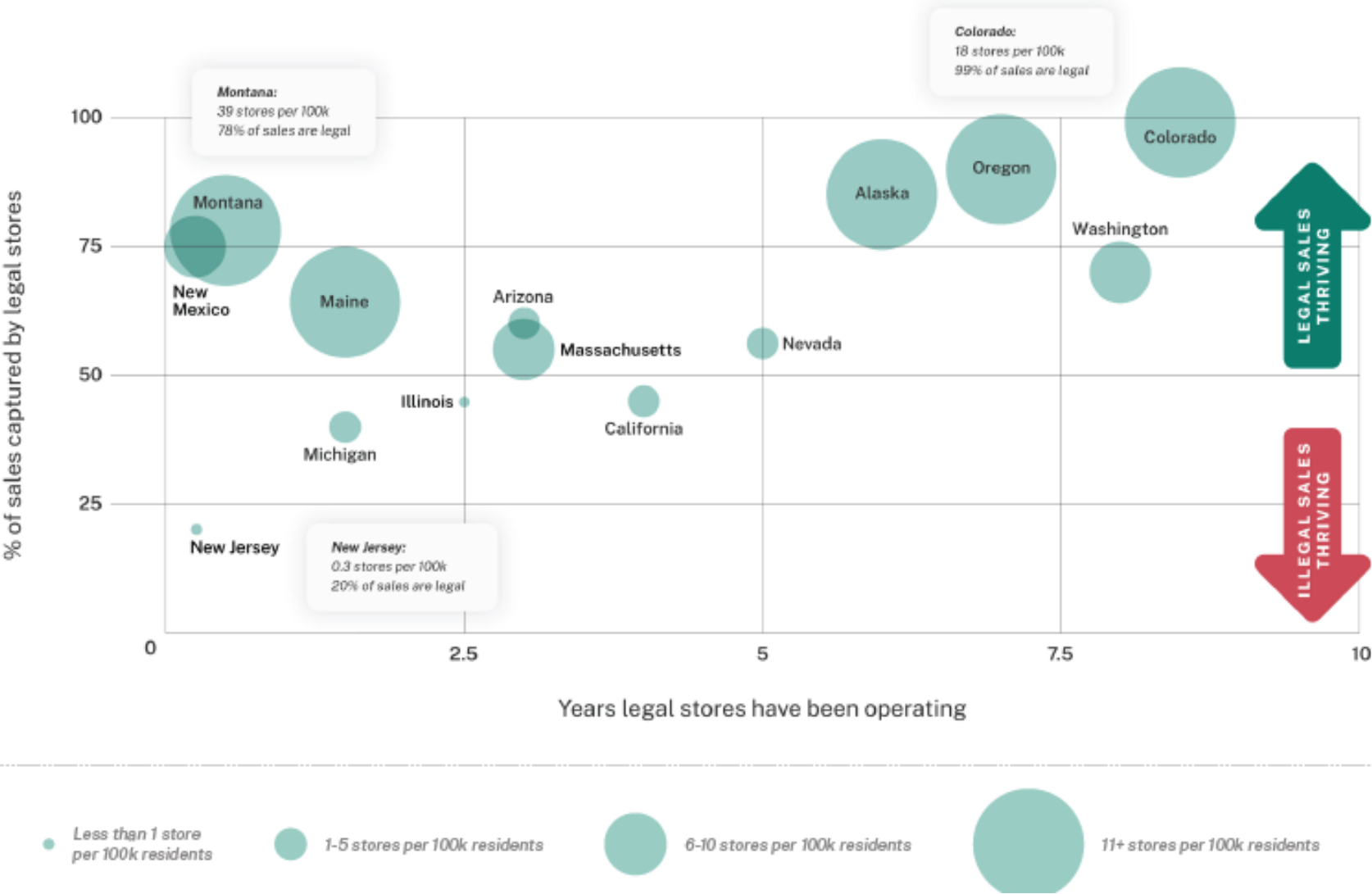
- Expand the current number of retail commercial cannabis permits – up to ten (10)
- Adding a new section allowing the Council to consider alternative sites for a retail cannabis business under appeal
- Cleanup from 2021 updates to permit modifications to ownership interest

Step 2

- Align retail permits with non-retail permits
 - No cap on number permits and no merit based criteria
 - Rely on distances from sensitive uses and allowable zoning districts
- Modifications to local ownership and background to rely on State permitting process – no duplication or more stringent requirements
- Other possible changes
 - Expanding permitted zones
 - Allowing operations in “City Center”
 - Creating a more streamlined process for non-retail cannabis permits
 - Other updates based on community input and Council direction
