#### Top Responses by Category

- <u>Housing</u>: decent, safe, affordable housing (affordable housing)
- <u>Public Service</u>: services for special needs (elderly, DV victims, and disabled)
- <u>Neighborhood Improvement</u>: building or improving infrastructure and streetscapes
- Economic Development: projects that increase jobs

- affordable homeownership opportunities
- (affordable rental housing not included as survey option)
