**WHEREAS,** Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, and Asexual Pride celebrates human diversity and takes a position against discrimination; and

- WHEREAS, The LGBTQIA+ community has worked tirelessly for respect, equality and their very right to exist. Their battles have been fought in the courts, from marriage equality to demanding equal protection under the law.
- **WHEREAS,** LGBTQIA+ community members are historically more vulnerable to sanctioned violence than their heterosexual and cisgender counterparts and there is a need for more resources for LGBTQIA+ youth; and
- **WHEREAS,** The City of Merced actively supports fostering inclusivity and re-affirmation of all its residents and acknowledges the efforts of the Central Valley Pride to move towards a unified City.
