C. SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

C.1. City Manager Presentation - City Manager Steve Carrigan

City Manager Steve CARRIGAN spoke about his first month in his position. He spoke about his priorities being public safety, jobs, and the homeless situation in Merced. He explained his "open door" policy and encouraged citizens to contact him.

C.2. City Clerk Presentation - Interim Assistant City Clerk John Tresidder
