

Sec. 7XX. – Tax Transparency Commission.

There shall be a Tax Transparency Commission consisting of not less than seven (7) nor more than nine (9) members to be appointed by the City Council from the qualified electors of the City. Six (6) members will be appointed from each of the six (6) districts and the remaining member(s) will be appointed at large, and no member of said commission shall hold any paid office or employment in the city government. Should district appointments remain vacant for more than ninety (90) days, the City Council has the authority and may elect to appoint an at large member to fill the vacancy. The Tax Transparency Commission shall meet quarterly, but not less than once per year.

Sec. 7XX. – Tax Transparency Commission—Powers and Duties.

The Tax Transparency Commission shall have authority to:

- A. Review the projected revenue and expenditures for the funds generated by each general or special tax measure.
- B. Make budget recommendations to the City Council in accordance with and to maintain compliance with each general or special tax measure.
- C. Review annual audits of each general or special tax measure and report any findings to the City Council.
