The crux of the issue is **flavors**

- e-juice compounds
 - Solvent: propylene glycol (PG) and glycerol
 - Flavor chemical: Diacetyl
 - Flavors including vanilla, caramel, and coconut
 - POPCORN LUNG
 - Flavor chemicals: aldehydes benzaldehyde, cinnamaldehyde, citral, ethylvanillin and vanillin
 - Flavors in cherry, vanilla, and cinnamon flavor bases
 - When mixed with PG and glycerol, converts to acetals
 - Acetals activate TRPA1 and TRPV1 irritant receptors
 - Effects begin in e-liquid storage phase, not just vaping





Flavors in general are harmful

• Flavors is not just an issue with e-cigarettes!







The truth is, flavors includes menthol

- Menthols have traditionally been used to target vulnerable groups
 - Youth, African Americans, and women (Caraballo & Asman, 2011; Cruz et al., 2010)
 - ~50% of youth smoke menthol cigarettes (Truth Initiative, 2019)
 - 88% of African Americans smoke menthol (Truth Initiative, 2019)
- Menthol *increases nicotine dependence!*
 - Reduces the time between needing nicotine among middle school smokers (Hersey et al., 2010)
 - Youth who initiate with menthols 80% more likely to become established smokers (Nonnemaker et al., 2012)



Youth and Flavors

- Most youth initiating tobacco use start with a flavor
- A recent article in the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA) demonstrates

Scientific Interpretation

- Given the market share of flavors, in order to prevent youth uptake, it is important to create a flavor-free tobacco environment
 - This includes all tobacco products and all flavors, including mint and menthol
- Elimination of flavors would also be beneficial to adult smokers who want to quit smoking
 - Flavors may be a reason why most adult former smokers who use e-cigs, continue to be hooked on nicotine via e-cigs




86.9% of all adult cigarette smokers began smoking by the age of 18


The Problem

- Flavored products threaten to undermine efforts to reduce youth tobacco use, putting a new generation of kids at risk of nicotine addiction and serious health harms that result from tobacco use
- Cheap tobacco products are affordable and attractive to youth
- More available in lowincome communities of color

Benefits of a local Tobacco Retail License

- Self-funded enforcement program
 - o through the annual renewal fee
- Coordination of tobacco regulations
 - violations of an existing local, state, or federal tobacco regulation violates the license

• Plug-ins


- may include plug-in provisions to restrict location of tobacco retailers, flavored tobacco products, etc.
- Protect youth
 - reduce illegal sales of tobacco products to minors





Why a Tobacco Retail Licensing Program?

- Provides education to businesses on tobacco law
- Provides ongoing, consistent enforcement to prevent tobacco sales to minors



To Report an Unlawful Tobacco Sale Call 1-800-5 ASK-4-ID

U.S. Armed Forces active duty personnel with military ID must be at least 18 years of age Valid Identification May Be Required

This sign must be readable by the consumer and must not be altered, covered or obliterated in whole or in part

Tobacco Retail License (TRL)

VS.

State-level TRL

- Renewed annually
- Target cigarette tax evasion
 & black market sales
- Doesn't fund local enforcement
- Doesn't include extra retail policies

Local TRL

- Tobacco retailers obtain a local license and renew annually
- Local level funding for enforcement
- May include plug-in provisions
