Background

- March 2017 Council directs Staff to look at Feasibility of Quiet Zones
- April 2018 Staff receives two (2) proposal for study
- June 2018 Staff presents proposals to Council
- July 2018 Proposals are resubmitted with reduced scope
- November 2018 Council Awards Contract for Feasibility Study
- January 2019 Council directs staff to look at funding and plan for updates to crossings

What is a Quiet Zone?

- Stretch of Track (1/2 mile minimum) where Train Horns are not Required
 - Exceptions include:
 - Emergencies
 - Person on Track
 - Workers within 25 feet of Track



Railroad Safety

- 14 Supplemental Safety Measures (SSM) established by FRA
- FRA Analyses show no statistically significant difference in accident numbers, except 2010-2011
- 1972 12,000 collisions, 2017 2100 incidents
- Operation Lifesaver
- Fencing
