**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 5.40 of the Merced Municipal Code, Security Enforcement Alliance, has applied to the City of Merced for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate a private patrol and security service within the City; and

SECTION 2. A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is hereby granted to Security Enforcement Alliance.
