Campaign Objectives

Tip Lines

- Provided multiple methods to report illegal fireworks instead of inundating 9-1-1 system.
- Celebrate Safe hotline, Merced Connect App and dedicated email address.
- Expanded dispatch center on July 3 and 4th staffed with volunteers from the community.

Enforcement

• Increased enforcement and community presence by Police and Fire Department personnel on July 2nd through 5th.

Enforcement Activities - Fire



- Crews patrolled all areas of the City from July 2nd – July 5th
- Contacted numerous citizens and educated them on the use of illegal fireworks
- Issued two (2) administrative citations (\$1,000 each)
- Confiscated 175 pounds of illegal fireworks
- Staffing
 - All on duty companies
 - Chief Officers

Enforcement Activities - PD

- Additional staffing on July 3rd and 4th to patrol areas of the City
- 3 citations issued
 - 2 Health and Safety Code
 - 1 MMC
- Patrol presence around hot spot areas of the City
- Staffing
 - On duty patrol
 - 1 Sergeant
 - 4 additional officers





Safe Surrender

 Allowed the public to dispose of any fireworks (safe and sane or illegal) safely and without any fear of prosecution.
