Merced Black Lives Matter Street Mural Project COVID-19 Plan

1. Guiding Principles to Keep in Mind

- a) Consult CDC Website guidelines, local health officials and City of Merced Staff about recommended COVID-19 policies for events and gatherings (e.g. street mural prep and painting).
 - a. Merced Street Mural Project will have no more than 20 attendees per hourly time segments during street mural prep and painting.
- b) Plan to allow for social distancing before, during, and after the event (e.g., limiting attendance and modifying layouts before the event, and staggering exit times after the event).
- c) Develop attendance time options to help reduce the number of attendees at the event.
- d) Plan for educating attendees about cloth face coverings, and communicate the importance of wearing them to both staff and attendees.
- e) Plan for educating staff and attendees to ensure they know that they should not come to the event if they become sick with COVID-19 symptoms, test positive for COVID-19, or have been exposed to someone with symptoms or someone suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19.
- f) Purchase adequate supplies to minimize sharing of materials, or limit use to one per family or group of individuals at a time, and clean and disinfect between use.
- g) Ensure adequate supplies to support healthy hygiene behaviors. Supplies include soap, water, hand sanitizer containing at least 60 percent alcohol, paper towels, tissues, disinfectant wipes, cloth face coverings (as feasible), and no-touch trash cans.

- 11am-12pm: Finish street mural painting
- 12pm-2pm: Street clean-up and removal of painting supplies
- 2pm-midnight: Street Closure in-tact for paint to dry
