Dear Council Members,

We are writing this letter to supplement our appreciation for use of the Merced Community Senior Center.

The Superior Court of California, County of Merced is looking for a large space to conduct jury services, including jury selection and jury trials. The Jury Assembly Room at the courthouse is not large enough to accommodate a large group with social distancing during the COVID-19 pandemic. Specifically, the Court is requesting use of the Merced Community Senior Center from August 10th, 2020 through October 30th, 2020, or a timeframe acceptable to the Council and asks for the facility fees be waived. The_Court is a public agency faced with budget reductions, as are most public agencies during this difficult time.

While the Court is requesting availability of the center Monday through Friday at this time, this is dependent on the scheduling of jury trials and may not be needed each day requested. The Court will communicate at least 1 business day in advance with the city designee to confirm the actual dates of use. In addition, the Court will supply a state certified/licensed janitorial service if necessary. Court security is provided by Merced County Sheriff's Department and will be onsite during the jury service and trial.

The Court recognizes that this request is unique and challenging at the same time. During the months of June and July, we successfully utilized El Capitan High School's theater for these services. With schools resuming in August, the high school needs the facility to address staff training and development. The Court will exercise all safety precautions while using the facility, including but not limited to, automated temperature screening, COVID screening signage, providing personal protective equipment such as masks, gloves, and hand sanitizations.
