CITY COUNCIL PRIORITIES

DISCUSSION

November 4, 2019, the City entered into an Agreement for Professional Services ("Agreement") with the law firm of Goldman, Magdalin & Krikes, LLP for workers' compensation legal services in support of the City Attorney's Department.

On April 28, 2021, the City entered into a First Amendment to Agreement for additional services to provide employee training on the workers' compensation process and industrial disability retirement process.

On May 17, 2023, the City entered into a Second Amendment to Agreement to adjust the hourly compensation rate.

Co-Founding Partner George Krikes separated from the law firm and the firm welcomed new partner Derek Straatsma, necessitating a name change of the firm. Effective February 1, 2024, Goldman, Magdalin & Krikes, LLP has changed to Goldman Magdalin Straatsma, LLP.
