## **AUTHORITY**

This request amends the designated no parking zones listed in Merced Municipal Code (MMC) Section 10.28.230. This request also amends the freight and passenger loading zones listed in MMC Section 10.32.050 and adds MMC Section 10.32.051, "Freight and Passenger Loading Zones - Locations - Seven A.M. to Four P.M.".

The California Vehicle Code (CVC) gives a local body (or official) jurisdiction for traffic control devices, provided the devices are installed in accordance with the State Traffic Manual.
