DISCUSSION

In May 2016, the City Development Services entered into a \$27,000.00 professional services agreement with Interwest Consulting Group Inc. for building and planning services. The City's Assistant Building Official, has taken a temporary position with the City Fire Department. Staff for middle management and oversight within the Inspection Services division are still needed. The services will be necessary for a minimum of one-year.

This contract will be funded with no new appropriation of funds in the FY 2016-17 Budget, but will utilize the funding approved in the FY 2016-17 budget in the professional services line.
