The existing facts and circumstances are as follows: On December 3, 2018, Harvest of Merced, at an open and public meeting, stated that “. . . Ordinance 24-80 as applied to Harvest violated Harvest’s due process rights and because none of the public records indicate that a school exists on 760 W. 13th Street. Harvest would be forced to look to the Courts to protect and uphold its legal rights. . .”
