## DISCUSSION

During the September 19, 2019 Arts and Culture Advisory Commission meeting, staff and Commissioner's reviewed and discussed a proposed Art and Culture Policy. At the October 17, 2019 Arts and Culture Advisory Commission meeting, Commissioner's and Staff discussed developing policies to facilitate the process to place art in the City, removing art pieces, and involving other organizations. The Commission also voted on establishing a Sub-Committee and appointed Chair Colton Dennis and Commissioner's Monika Modest and Diana Odom-Gunn. Chair Colton Dennis gave an update on the Arts and Culture policy at the January 23<sup>rd</sup> Arts and Culture Advisory Commission meeting.

At the August 17, 2020 City Council Meeting, the City Council reviewed and discussed the proposed Arts and Culture Policy and directed staff to make slight changes to the policy regarding the use of City property.

The Arts and Culture Policy is ready for the Arts and Culture Advisory Commission to review, approve and make a recommendation for City Council approval.
