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**SUBJECT:** <u>Award Bid to Phase 1 Construction for the Water Meter Retrofitting Program Project</u> <u>108068</u>

## **REPORT IN BRIEF**

Consider awarding a construction contract in the amount of \$112,600 for the cleaning of approximately 7,000 existing water boxes in various locations within the City of Merced.

## RECOMMENDATION

**City Council** - Adopt a motion:

A. Awarding the bid for the Water Meter Retrofitting Program, Project 108068, to Phase 1 Construction, in the amount of \$112,600; and,

B. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the necessary documents and to approve change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract.

## ALTERNATIVES

- 1. Approve, as recommended by staff; or,
- 2. Approve, subject to conditions other than recommended by staff (identify specific findings and/or conditions amended to be addressed in the motion); or,
- 3. Deny; or,
- 4. Refer to staff for reconsideration of specific items (specific items to be addressed in the motion); or,
- 5. Continue to a future meeting (date and time to be specified in the motion).

## AUTHORITY

Charter of the City of Merced, Article XI, Section 1109 - Contracts on Public Works, and Merced Municipal Code Chapter 3.04, Article IV - Public Works Contracts. Every project involving an expenditure of more than sixty-one thousand seven hundred and eighty-five dollars (\$61,785) for the construction or improvements of public buildings, works, streets, drains, sewers, utilities, park, and playgrounds shall be let by contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder after notice by publication in the official newspaper by one or more insertions, the first of which shall be at least ten days before the time for opening bids.

# **CITY COUNCIL PRIORITIES**

As provided for in the 2015-16 Adopted Budget.

## DISCUSSION

The work to be done consists, in general, of cleaning dirt and debris out of approximately 7,000 existing water service boxes in various locations within the City of Merced. The dirt and debris will be removed from the full depth of the entire meter box to allow for the future installation of water meters.

City staff prepared plans and specifications, and the project was advertised for bids. Bids were opened on July 14, 2015, with the following results:

- 1. Phase 1 Construction (Atwater, CA) \$112,600
- 2. Lawrence Backhoe Service (Atwater, CA) \$117,700
- 3. Clean Cut Landscape (Clovis, CA) \$123,200
- 4. Rolfe Construction (Atwater, CA) \$182,000
- 5. Taylor Backhoe Service (Merced, CA) \$263,530
- 6. West Valley Construction (San Jose, CA) \$344,350

The engineers estimate was \$105,000.

The following is the proposed budget for the project:

Construction	\$ 112,600.00
Contingency	\$ 11,260.00
Engineering, Testing, Inspection	\$ 11,260.00
Total	\$ 135,120.00

## IMPACT ON CITY RESOURCES

This project was established as a Capital Improvement Project and account 556-1118-637.65-00-108068 contains sufficient funding to complete the project.
