DISCUSSION

The City of Merced must enter into a Master Agreement with the State of California, acting by and through its Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to continue receiving certain federal-aid funds. In addition to the Master Agreement, the City must execute and return a project-specific Program Supplemental for each individual project within a 90-day period unless otherwise agreed by the State in writing.

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This Master Agreement would replace the old agreement with new and updated laws and regulations.

IMPACT ON CITY RESOURCES

The City of Merced would not be eligible to receive certain federal-aid funds without this Master Agreement in place.
